ONE CHANGE WE HAVE MADE IN THE 2002 WAVE IS THAT WE DO NOT REVEAL ANY INFORMATION ABOUT PRIOR REPORTS OF CHRONIC CONDITIONS OF A LIVING PERSON TO A NEW REPORTER. THUS, IF THE PERSON IS LIVING AND THE REINTERVIEW RESPONDENT/REPORTER FOR THIS IW IS DIFFERENT FROM THE LAST IW, THE NEW REPORTER RECEIVES THE SAME PHRASING AS A NEW INTERVIEW R FOR THE BASE QUESTIONS ABOUT EACH HEALTH CONDITION. SPECIFICALLY NEW REPORTERS ARE ASKED WHETHER THE SAMPLED R HAS EVER HAD OR HAS EVER BEEN TOLD BY A DOCTOR THAT HE/SHE HAS HAD CERTAIN HEALTH CONDITIONS. PROXIES FOR EXIT Rs RECEIVE PHRASING THAT IS INDEPENDENT OF WHETHER THE PROXY IS THE SAME PERSON AS AT THE LAST IW.
