Assignment specifications for V201:

If R has severe pain {C104=1 and C105=3} then V201=1

Else, if R has lung disease {C030 in (1,3)} then V201=2

Else, if R has diabetes {C010 in (1,3)} then V201=4

Else, if R has a heart problem {C036 in (1,3)} then V201=5

Else, if R has high blood pressure but no arthritis {C005 in (1,3) and C070 not in (1,3)}, or R has both high blood pressure and arthritis and random number is less than .300 {C005 in (1,3) and C070 in (1,3) and Z246_Random1_999 < 300} then V201=6

Else, V201=9
